Astrakhan is a major transport hub. Transport links with all the countries of the world are maintained mainly via Moscow or other cities, which depends on the initial point of your itinerary. Please contact your local travel agency that could help you select the best route. You can also reach Astrakhan by train.

How to Get to Astrakhan by Plane

Thanks to its international airport, Astrakhan can be reached by air. It is the fastest way to get to our city. It takes 2 hours to get to Astrakhan from Moscow.

How to Get to Astrakhan by Train

There is a railway station in the city center. You can take a train to Astrakhan departing from Moscow, Saint Petersburg, Volgograd, Samara, Kazan, Makhachkala, Kharkov, Odessa, Tambov, Lipetsk, Tver, Rostov-on-Don, Krasnodar, Sochi, Omsk, Novosibirsk, Baku, Tyumen, and many other cities of Russia. Railway links with far-away countries are maintained mainly via Moscow. It takes 22 hours to get from Moscow to Astrakhan by train. Trains depart from Moscow's Paveletsky railway station.
